

# **Issue of a Health Card**

#### **About the Service**

This service enables patients to apply for a Health Card, which entitles the owner to receive health and treatment services at MOHAP health facilities.

#### **Service Process**

- A user must first register in the e-services portal and create a username and password. Thereafter, they can click on the service link to access the electronic system and follow the required steps:
- Submit an application through the smart service in a typing center or through the electronic service for individual users, service provision centers in health registration centers, or companies registered in the system
- Pay the service fee
- The employee concerned at the Health Registration department will verify the application
- If the application is approved, the applicant will be notified via an SMS
- Once approved, the applicant can begin to benefit from the service
- In case of non-approval or rejection of the application, a user may modify the request and re-submit it for approval

### **Required Documents**

- A recent passport-type photo with white background
- A copy of valid passport (first page and second page)
- A copy of ID card (both sides) or ID application form
- Citizens: a copy of the Family Book
- Expatriates: a copy of valid residence or visa, in case of first-time entry
- Diplomats: a copy of diplomatic passport, a copy of the yellow card issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and written proof of diplomatic employment issued by the consulate
- Other attachments (including lease contract, birth certificate, marriage contract, etc.)

### **Conditions & Requirements**

- 1. A citizen's wife must be sponsored by him and registered in the Family Book.
- 2. Health Card are not issued in case of divorce or the husband's death, even if his residence is sponsored by his citizen sons.
- 3. The applicant must have a valid residency in UAE.
- 4. Issuance of health card is linked to the applicant's place of residence.
- 5. Health Cards for citizens and GCC citizens are valid for four years, while cards of non-citizens are valid for one year
- 6. Proof of residence such as lease contract, electricity bill, property ownership contract is required.
- 7. Only one card is issued per person.
- 8. The individual user can submit 10 transactions per year through his activated account, with his registered name, ID, phone number and email address
- 9. An actual Health Card is no longer issued as it is linked to the Emirates ID card.
- 10. Health Cards for newborns can be registered and issued through special cases, and the registration number can be used in the birth notification instead of the ID card.

- 11. Children of female citizens shall be under the category of citizens.
- 12. The validity of the Health Card may not match the remaining validity of the ID card, however the ID card must be valid when applying for the Health Card.
- 13. A Health Card may be renewed no more than one month before its expiry date
